Background

The **my health** app, is designed to encourage consumers to take a more proactive role in managing their health.

my health is a secure and convenient way to view key health information, it's fast, easy, and secure - and you can access and share it all from the palm of your hand. The **my health** app is an initiative of the Australian Government and provides access to:

- electronic prescriptions and Active Script List (accessed through the pharmacy software MySL interface)
- emergency contact details

- medicine information history
- pathology results, including COVID-19 test results
- · proof of vaccination history and upcoming immunisations
- allergy and reactions information
- hospital discharge summaries
- · advance care planning documents
- find and book a health service.

Key messaging

Key messages can be used to build out communications relevant for your channels:

- my health allows for secure and convenient management of key health information on the go, and available wherever and whenever it's needed.
- Access electronic prescriptions and script lists directly through the my health app.
- Find and book health services, add and update emergency contact details and many other useful features.
- The app is available for download from all iOS and Android app stores by searching for "my health gov".

Key features now include:

- View and manage electronic prescriptions
- Add or edit medicines, allergies, and adverse reactions
- Add, update, and view emergency contact information
- Link an Active Script List (ASL), once registered at a pharmacy
- View Advanced Care Plans that have been uploaded to My Health Record.

These features and more make managing health information more convenient, especially for carers and those with chronic or complex health conditions.
