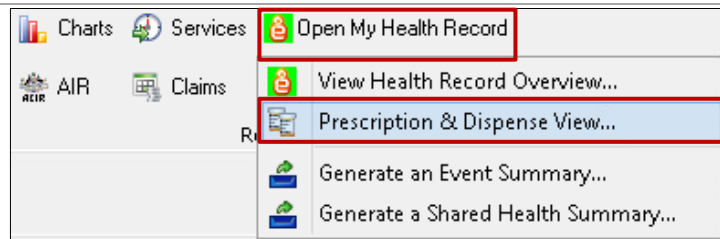


Accessing Prescription and Dispense View

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

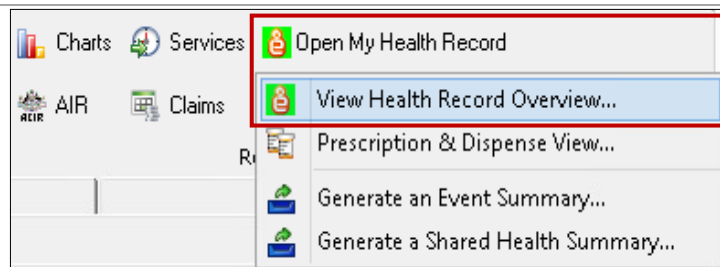
STEP 1:

To gain access to the patient's Prescription and Dispense view, click on **Open My Health Record**, then select **Prescription and Dispense view** from the drop-down menu.



STEP 2:

Alternatively, you can select **View Health Record Overview**, and scroll down and click on the **Prescription and Dispense view** tile.



Accessing Prescription and Dispense View continued

STEP 3:

The default date range displays two years of data. To change, enter the date range and click **refresh**.

The **Prescription and Dispense view** will auto populate into a collapsed medications overview. By default, the information is sorted by prescribed date and grouped by prescription.

You can also **group by** the Generic name, PBS Item Code or Brand name of the medication.

STEP 4:

Expand the view by clicking on a row to view further details about the medicine, then click to open.
