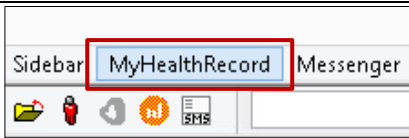
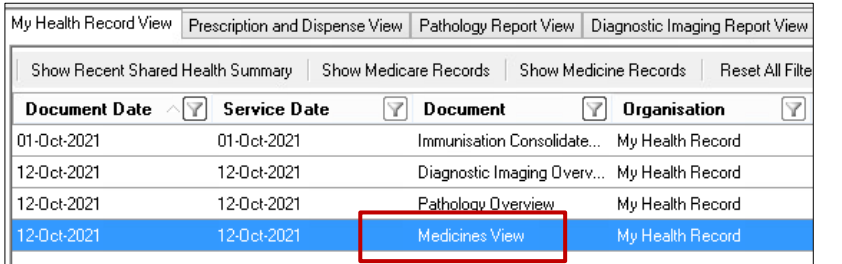
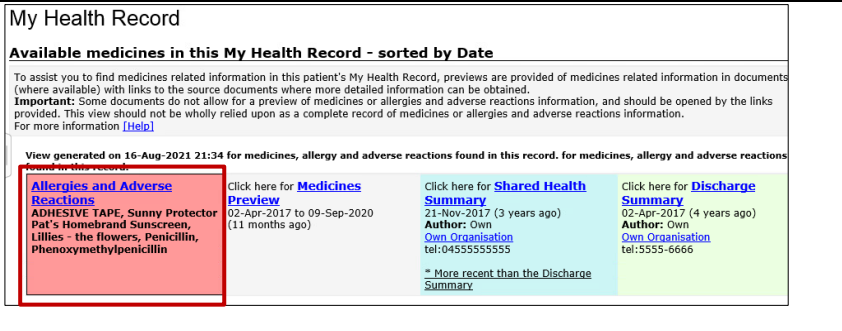


# Accessing the Medicines Information View

*Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system*

<p><b>STEP 1:</b> To access the patient's My Health Record, select <b>My Health Record</b> from the top menu.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 2:</b> The Document List will appear, displaying documents in the patient's My Health Record (subject to any search filters which are set).  Click on the <b>Medicines View</b> in the Document list (it will appear near the top of the list). When highlighted, a preview will appear below the list.  Double click to open and view the document.</p>	
<p><b>STEP 3:</b> The <b>Medicines View</b> will display available medicines and allergy information held in a patient's My Health Record with the <b>Allergies and Adverse Reactions tab</b> displayed by default.</p>	

**STEP 4:**

To view a patient’s medicines information, click on the **Medicines Preview**.

By default, the medicines information is sorted by date. To sort the medicines by active ingredient, click on **Medicine – Active Ingredient(s)**.

You can click on any hyperlinks within the list of medicines to view the original source document (e.g. Discharge Summary or Event Summary).

The information in the **Medicines Information View** is gathered from:

- The patient’s most recent (and up to two years’) **Prescription and Dispense records** and other **PBS claims information**
- The patient’s most recent **Shared Health Summary** and **Discharge Summary**
- Recent **Event Summaries, Specialist Letters** and **e-Referral notes** uploaded to the patient’s record since their latest shared health summary, and
- The patient’s **Personal Health Summary** that may include any allergies or adverse reactions and other key information.

If available, a link to the **Pharmacist Shared Medicines List** will also be provided in the Medicines Information View.
