

Request for diagnostic imaging report to not be sent to My Health Record

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

If your patient does not want a diagnostic imaging report uploaded to My Health Record, the diagnostic imaging provider should be notified by completing the steps below. This will not affect your current business process of requesting and receiving diagnostic imaging reports, it simply stops the information being sent to your patient's My Health Record on this occasion. We encourage you to discuss this with your patient as having access to test results in their My Health Record may improve their future healthcare.

STEP 1:

In **Medical Imaging Request**, tick **Do not send reports to My Health Record**.
