The statistics include information about registrations, document uploads and prescription/dispense documents.

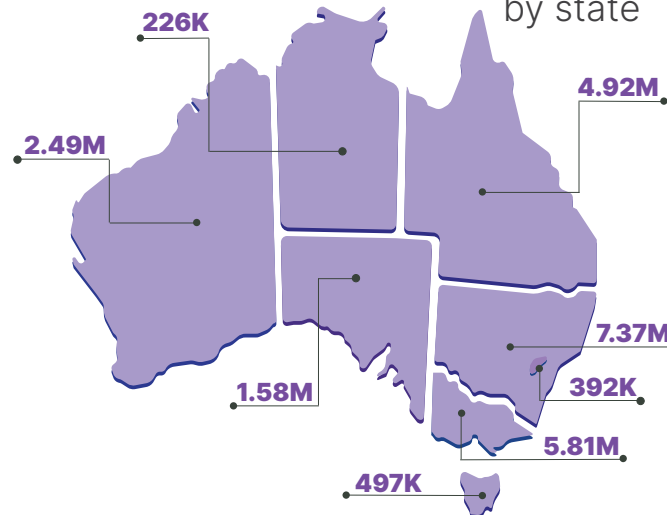

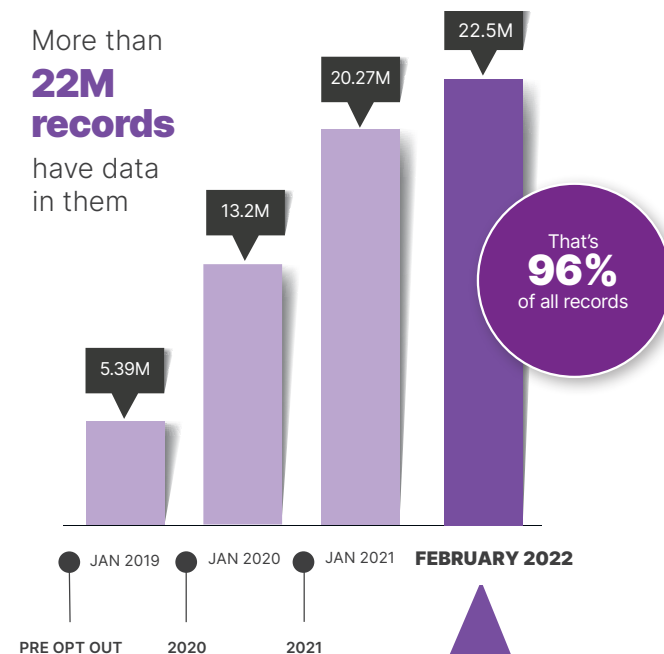
**Use of My Health Record increased considerably during the pandemic.**

The new COVID-19 dashboard is a convenient way to see COVID-19 related information in one place, including proof of vaccination documents and booster information. Consumers can now see COVID-19 PCR test results as soon as they are uploaded, giving faster access to key health information.

Australians trust My Health Record to keep their health information secure and can decide which healthcare providers can view their record.

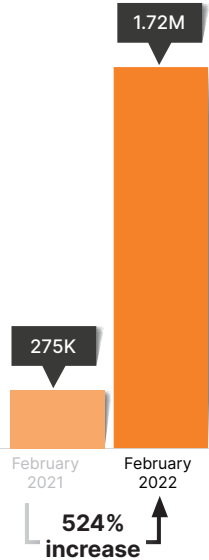
This month **over 14K** people checked who had accessed their record.



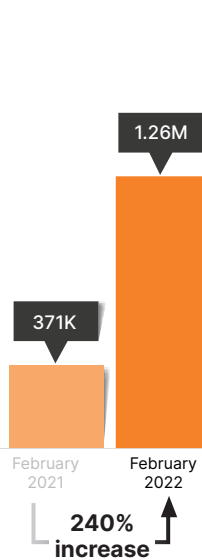
What about **security** and **privacy**?

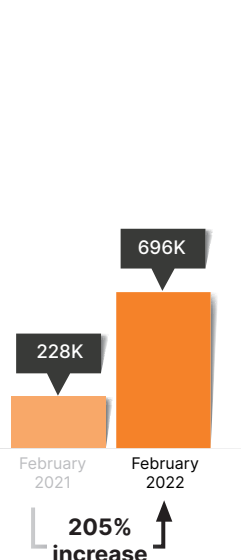

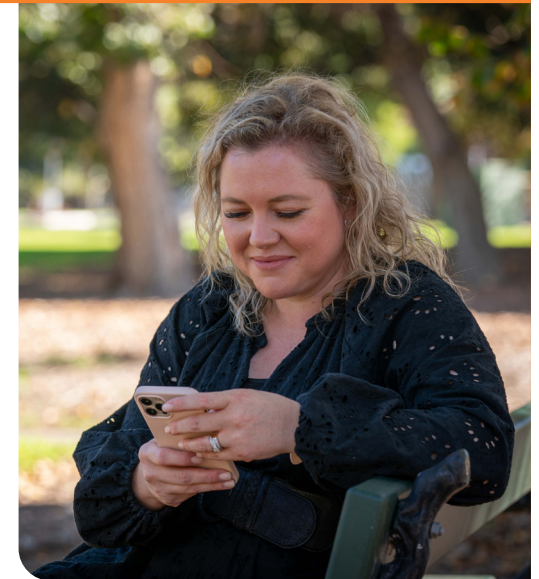
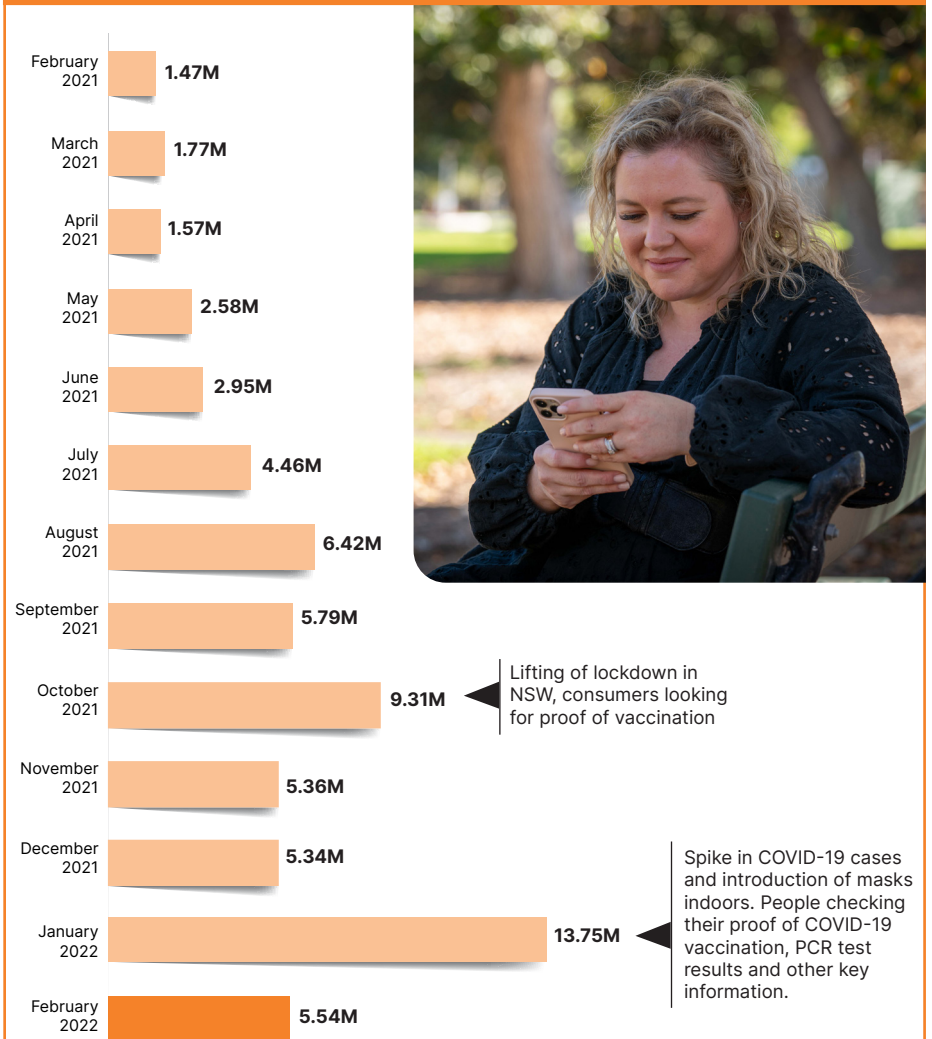

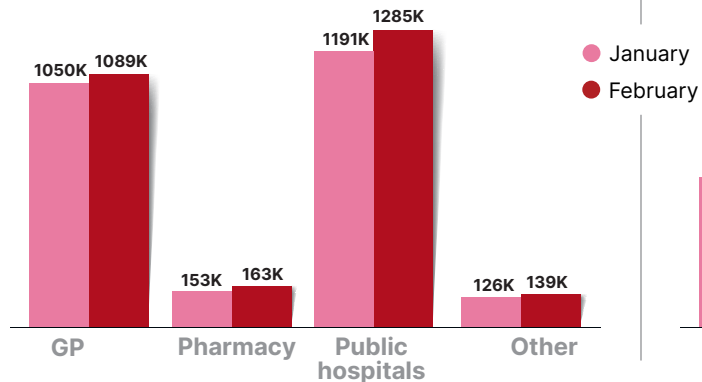


**20%** of specialists are registered  
**9%** have used My Health Record

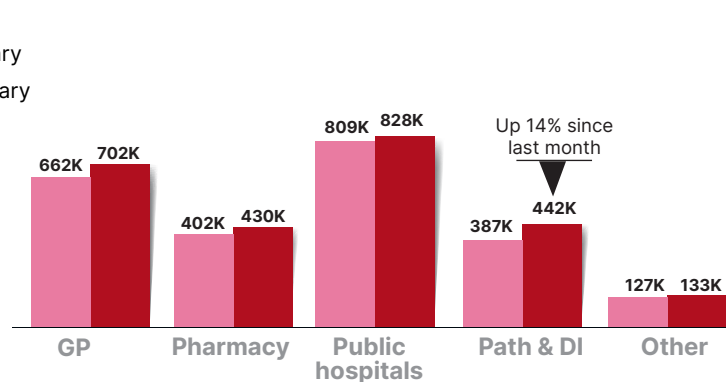
Specialists started accessing My Health Record via their clinical information systems in late 2021. Documents uploaded by specialists and viewed by other healthcare providers increased by 17% in February.

Documents **uploaded** which were **viewed by other organisations**



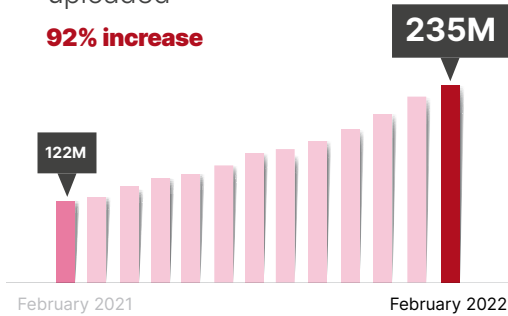
## Year on year increase Feb 21 - Feb 22

Public hospital viewing in the past 12 months is more than double the previous 12 months. Viewing of documents uploaded by other healthcare providers is now **1.28M**, up 8% since last month

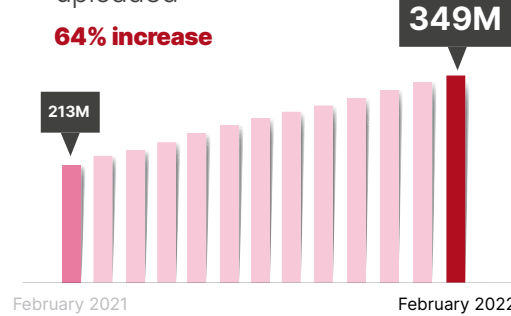

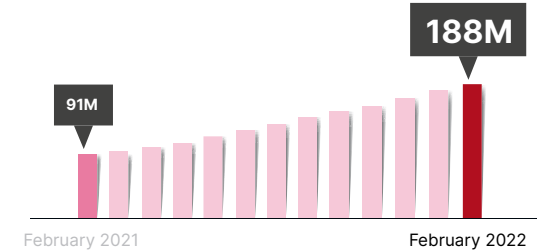

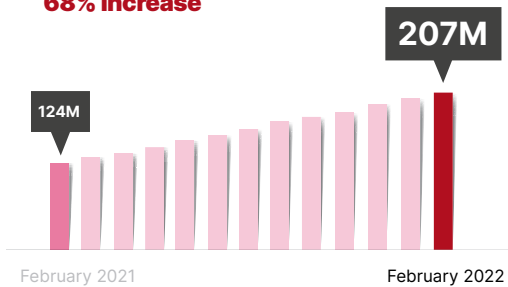

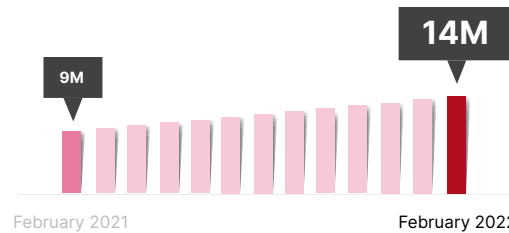
