
The Australian Digital Health Agency publishes a range of statistics about how My Health Record is being used by healthcare provider organisations and patients.






There are over


uploaded by a healthcare provider like hospitals, pathologists and increasingly specialists.

Australians trust My Health Record to keep their health information secure and can decide which healthcare providers can view their record.


This month over **15K** people checked who had accessed their record.




What about **security** and **privacy?**














Volume of diagnostic imaging
