
Statistics and Insights NOVEMBER 2022




THE **BIG** PICTURE














There are over **852M**

CLINICAL DOCUMENTS


uploaded by a healthcare provider like hospitals, pathologists and radiologists.

262K people have registered for a My Health Record who had previously opted out or cancelled.




HOW ARE **PEOPLE** USING IT?




How are healthcare professionals using these documents?









Volume of **discharge summary** reports uploaded

34% increase




Volume of **pathology reports** uploaded

72% increase




Volume of **diagnostic imaging reports** uploaded
