STEP 4: Once you have clicked the ' Upload Document to My Health Record' button a pop up will appear. Click Upload.	 Upload to My Health Record Warnings Healthcare Providers should recommend patients/clients choose to receive SMS or email notifications whenever Advance Care Planning documents are uploaded, reinstated or removed from their My Health Record. Healthcare Providers can only upload Advance Care Planning documents when instructed by the patient/client. If you change any Advance care planning document(s), including uploading or removing documents from the My Health Record, you should recommend the individual informs their Advance Care Document custodian.
