

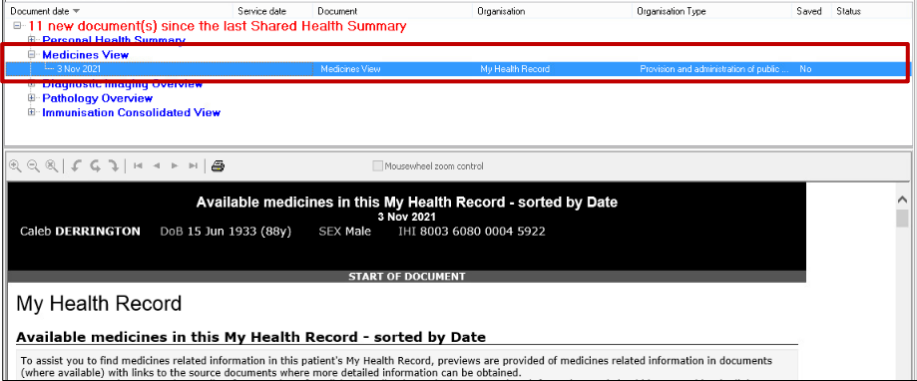



Accessing the Medicines Information View

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system

<p>STEP 1: To access the patient's My Health Record, select the My Health Record icon above the Summary Views panel.</p>	
<p>STEP 2: The My Health Record Documents screen will display with the Clinical Documents tab selected by default.</p> <p>Click the Refresh button to show the list of documents in the patient's My Health Record (subject to any filters that are set).</p>	
<p>STEP 3: Click on the plus symbol to expand the Medicines View document list, then select the row for Medicines View. The document details will display in the panel below.</p>	
<p>STEP 4: Click the View Document button for a full screen view of the Medicines View document</p>

<p>STEP 5: The Medicines View will display available medicines and allergy information held in a patient's My Health Record with the Allergies and Adverse Reactions tab displayed by default.</p>	<p>My Health Record</p> <p>Available medicines in this My Health Record - sorted by Date</p> <p>To assist you to find medicines related information in this patient's My Health Record, previews are provided of medicines related information in documents (where available) with links to the source documents where more detailed information can be obtained. 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<p>STEP 6: To view a patient's medicines information, click on the Medicines Preview.</p> <p>By default, the medicines information is sorted by date.
