Uploading an Event Summary

Note: These steps assume that your software is connected to the My Health Record system, the patient has a My Health Record and their individual healthcare identifier (IHI) has been validated in your system


STEP 1: Once you have opened the patient's local medical record and entered the My Health Red clinical information/notes for the 45-49 Health Check consultation, select the Quick Documents icon (left-centre), then select My Health Record Summaries and Event Summary. STEP 2: Past Consultations Select a Consultation A Past Consultations box may appear. Tick/untick the items to include/not include in the Event Summary, then select Next (Preview).

Uploading an Event Summary continued

STEP 4:

Review the information in the Event Summary to verify the information is correct.

Attest to the statement at the bottom of the screen, then select, **Confirm Content and Upload.**



STEP 5:

The Event Summary will also save to the patient's local medical record in the **Documents** tab.
